(pop = pop**ped**) **Rule 2:** To add "ed" to a word that ends in **two consonants**, just add "ed." (camp = camp**ed**) **Rule 3:** To add "ed" to a word that ends in a **silent "e,"** drop the silent "e" and then add "ed." (example bake**e** = baked)


